Care and Cleaning

## EASY CARE

**REGULAR CARE-** Periodically clean with a natural soap and rinse with water to keep fabric looking fresh and new. This process also prevents mildew.

**Stain Removal-** Spot wash by sponging briskly with a solution of natural soap in lukewarm water, no more than 100°F. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry.

For stubborn stains or suntan lotion, use a fabric spot remover. Follow the directions on the container. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and air dry.

**MILDEW REMOVAL-** Prepare a mild solution of one cup bleach plus two capfuls of natural soap per gallon of water. Spray on entire area and allow to soak in. If necessary, scrub vigorously with a sponge or clean cloth. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and air dry.

**STAIN CHART**

This chart contains our recommended cleaning methods of Sunsharp® fabric for some of the most common and toughest stains.

STAIN	RECOMMENDED CLEANING SOLUTIONS
BIRD DROPPINGS	dishwashing liquid (2 oz.) / 1 gallon water, or try Goo Gone Grease Cutter (a hand cleaner), Greased Lightning, or Clean Rite Purple Power (available at most retailers)
CATSUP OR MUSTARD	dishwashing liquid (2 oz.) / 1 gallon water
COFFEE	dishwashing liquid / water, white vinegar, volatile solvent (acetone)
MILDEW	bleach (1 cup) / dishwashing liquid (2 oz.) / 1 gallon water
SUNTAN LOTION	Pine Power® or pine oil detergent / water (mix as directed)
TREE SAP	Turpentine (100%), dishwashing liquid (2 oz.) / 1 gallon water
WINE	dishwashing liquid (2 oz.) / 1 gallon water / ammonia (4-8 oz.) / white vinegar (3 oz.)
